

Guidelines “PROM 2018”

1. The prom will be held on Friday, May 11, 2018 at the “Altoona Heritage Discovery Center” in Downtown Altoona from 7:30 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Formal dress is required for all attendees and must be worn throughout the event or you will be asked to leave. Dress shirts must be worn and buttoned at all times. No jeans or casual wear is permitted.
2. A junior or senior may invite **one** guest. A guest is a student in grade 9-12 at TAHS, a TAHS graduate under 21, a student under 21 enrolled in a GED or with a GED Certificate, a student from another district in grade 9-12, **a graduate from another district under 21, or a guest approved by the TAHS administration under 21.**
3. **All guests from outside of the Tyrone Area School District must submit “proof of age” with their GUEST registration form. This must contain the guest’s picture. It can be a copy of a valid driver’s license, military ID or ID card. If a student is under the age of 16, they must submit a copy of their current school ID card. This identification will be required for admission to “Prom 2018”- NO exceptions.**
4. **Prom/guest fees are \$40.00 per person (Check or money order should be made payable to “TAHS”).** All juniors, seniors, and their guests attending the prom must pay the fee. **Fees are non-refundable.** Students may participate in prom fundraisers to offset the cost of attending prom. Students may only use the profit from the fundraisers if they are attending the prom.
5. All students and their guests attending the prom are required to complete the “Prom 2018 Registration Form” or “Prom 2018 Guest Registration Form”. These forms are available outside Mrs. Marasco’s Room 238.
6. Prom Fees and Registration Forms should be placed in an envelope with your name and 1st period class clearly printed on it. Forms and fees for couples should be in the same envelope. If forms and fees are not placed in an envelope, they will not be accepted. **The forms and fees, paid in full, must be turned in to Mrs. Marasco in Room 238 on the following COLLECTION DATES: Monday, April 9th through Friday, April 13th.**
7. **Late forms will not be accepted and you will not be permitted to attend the prom.**
8. **Money owed to the Tyrone School District for prom registration fees, prom fundraisers, cafeteria bills, library fines, books, uniforms, class projects, and/or fundraisers from any TAHS club/group/class must be paid in full by Monday, May 7, 2018 to the main office. If bills and fines are not paid you will not be admitted into The Discovery Center for “TAHS Prom 2018”.**
9. **Table sign-up will be on Thursday, April 19, 2018 in Mrs. Marasco’s room 238.**
10. **All detentions must be completed by Tuesday, May 1, 2018 in order to attend to the prom. Any student on suspension on the date of the prom will not be permitted to attend.**
11. The prom is a school function and a privilege. All Tyrone Area High School Rules and Regulations from the Student Handbook / Code of Conduct will be enforced during the prom. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco of any kind are permitted at “Prom 2018”.
12. Admission tickets, royal court voting tickets, parking pass, and other pertinent information will be distributed to all students attending the prom on **Monday, May 7, 2018**, in the cafeteria. **For couples, the student whose name appears on the form stapled on top will receive the packet. If your guest is not an 11th or 12th grade TAHS student, please do not put their registration form on the top.**
13. School is in session on the day of the prom. If you do not attend school on May 11th, you will not be permitted to attend the prom. Dismissal for students will be 10:30 a.m. Students must submit a dismissal form signed by a parent/guardian to the attendance office by Thursday, May 10th to be dismissed at 10:30 a.m. for prom preparations. Dismissal forms will be available outside Mrs. Marasco’s room beginning May 1st.
14. Decorations at the “Altoona Heritage Discovery Center” may be viewed from 6:30 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. only.
15. Prom attendees will be announced during the “Grand March” (this is voluntary), which will begin at approximately 6:45 p.m. in the corridor beside the Kazmaier Center in Downtown Altoona.

10 or more absence unexcused- NO PROM
