Blue Knob Waiver / Acknowledgement of Risks / Equipment Rental Agreement

Skiing, snowboarding, and other snow sliding activities (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Snow Sports"), including the use of lifts, are dangerous sports with inherent and other risks. These risks include but are not limited to, variations in snow, steepness and terrain, trail side drop-offs, ice and icy conditions, moguls, rocks, trees, and other forms of forest growth or debris (above or below the surface), bare spots, lift towers, utility lines, poles and guide wires, snowmaking equipment and component parts, trail fences and control nets and the absence of such fences and nets, and other forms of natural or man-made obstacles on and/or off designated trails, marked and/or unmarked, as well as collisions with equipment, obstacles or other skiers; trail conditions vary constantly because of weather changes and skier use. These are some of the risks of snow sports. All of the inherent and other risks of snow sports present the risk of serious and/or fatal injury.

If I am renting Snowsports Equipment, I accept for the use as is, the equipment provided me by the Blue Knob Rental Shop and accept full responsibility for the care of the equipment. I further accept that I will return the equipment, in a clean undamaged condition to the Blue Knob Rental Shop by the agreed date and time, to avoid any additional charges.

I have read and understood the foregoing ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, /EQUIPMENT RENTAL AGREEMENT and I am voluntarily signing below, intending to be legally bound hereby. ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

Notice- All ski club members, grades 6-12, will be subject to the rules of TASD Academic Eligibility. This means that student's grades will be monitored weekly and those grades must not fall below:

1. 60% in two classes
2. An average total Grade Point Average below 1.67 -for all subjects
3. 20 or more absences per semester.

If a Ski Club member's grades are at or below the above stated conditions, that member will not attend ski club for the following week. **If a student misses Ski Club due to Academic Eligibility, that student will NOT be financially reimbursed for the missed week(s) of Ski Club.**

I understand that my ability to attend ski club will depend on my academic eligibility. I understand that if I am unable to attend, the week(s) missed will not be financially reimbursed.

Blue Knob Ski Trip RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All rules from the Middle School/High School Student Code of Conduct apply to ski club. This Form must be turned in to the middle/high school main office. If not turned in, you may find this form on the Tyrone Area School web site or see Mr. Plummer for this additional form.
2. Anyone found to be using drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products will automatically forfeit all his/her trips to Blue Knob or any other ski club trip. The individual will not be invited back to Ski Club in future years. There will be no refunds.
3. The student's equipment and belongings may be subject to search by T ASD administration/security each and/or any trip.
4. If a student is exhibiting suspicious behavior, the student and his/her parent will be informed a drug test is suggested at Tyrone Hospital upon arrival at Tyrone. If the parents or the student refuse to comply to the drug test, the student at that time automatically forfeits all his/her trips to Blue Knob or any other ski club trip. The individual will not be invited back to Ski Club in future years. There will be no refunds. Additionally, the refusal for testing will be treated as a first offense by the Tyrone School District
5. Student will be well behaved while on the bus. They are always to be seated , facing forward, calm, no loud music language or inappropriate language, no inappropriate behaviors. They must follow the directives given by the chaperones and/or bus driver.
6. Anyone found to be swearing, stealing, defacing property, or doing any action which is contrary to school rules or rules of the Blue Knob facility will automatically forfeit all his/her trips to Blue Knob or any other ski club trip. The individual will not be invited back to Ski Club in future years. There will be no refunds.
7. The buses leave Blue Knob at 8:30 PM. Anyone late for the bus will be the last to receive his/her lift ticket the following week.
8. Participants may cancel, but there are **no refunds with or without a Dr.'s excuse**. The student who cancels may have someone fill his/her spot only if the substitute skier has completed and turned in all required forms and paper work to Mr. Plummer one day prior to the date of the substitution.
There will be no refund for any portion of the day trip or the rental equipment.

9. Each participant is responsible for his/her own belongings. In the rental shop, lockers are available. If the participant chooses to not tock up his/her belongings, he/she runs the risk of having his/her equipment/possessions stolen. Neither the Tyrone School District its chaperones or the Blue Knob facility is responsible for the individual's possessions. Bring quarters and ones for lockers. Helmet rental \$10.
10. Students are responsible for returning all rental equipment, especially ski poles. Students will be charged for poles or other equipment if not tuned in.
11. Lift will be revoked by Blue Knob for reckless skiing/boarding or any other action that could endanger themselves or others. (swinging or bouncing lift chairs, out of control skiing/boarding, going on a closed trail, etc.) These rules exist for the safety of you and others.
12. Have fun, be careful and don't ski or board above your ability level. All skiers/boarders must realize that it's a hazardous sport and each person accepts responsibility for personal injury and damage to Blue Knob property.
13. Academic Eligibility- Grades must not fall below:
 1. 60% in No classes
 2. AN average total Grade Point Average below 1.67 for all subjects
 3. 20 or more absences per semester.

If your grades are at or below the above stated conditions, you will not attend Ski Club for the following week. There will be no financial reimbursements.

Times:

- * Be in the back-parking lot above the track by 2:45pm. For loading and departure. The bus will leave at 3:00pm. With/without you!
- * You are to be off the slopes at 8:00pm. and on the bus by 8:30pm. We will arrive back at the high school around 9:30pm. Pick up will be in the front of the school at the main office area.

Parents. Please be on time. No one likes to wait to be picked up or wait to have someone picked up. Please be considerate of your child and the chaperones on the trip.

Lessons:

- * Lessons and a helmet are a must for first time participants at a ski resort.
- * Lessons are for the 1st hour, then you are free to ski until 8:00 PM.

Food:

- * Blue Knob does have a cafeteria style restaurant, or you may pack a supper. Bring several bottles of water to remain hydrated. You may also bring a snack for on the bus.

Equipment and Belongings:

- * Lockers and lock ups for skis and boards are available at Blue Knob. Items (wallets, shoes, snowboards) that are left unattended have disappeared in the past. Chaperones are not responsible for any lost items. Bring quarters and ones for a locker.

Clothing:

- * Dress appropriate for the weather conditions at Blue Knob.
- * Socks- Get a good ski sock, preferably a wool blend. Wool wicks away moisture, and moisture causes feet to get cold. Do not wear several pairs of socks. They will wrinkle, bunch, and cut off circulation.
- * Undergarments- many students like an under-armor type garment. Duo-fold wool blend long johns are a good choice.
- * Gloves/Mittens- Heavy ski/snowboard type glove/mittens are a must. A thin or average winter glove/mitten will not be enough.
- * A helmet is strongly recommended and can be rented at Blue Knob for \$10.
- * Goggles- These are a good idea since Blue Knob can be very windy and snow making could be in progress. Since we ski at night, you will want to get a medium to light colored lens.
- * Ski/Snowboard Pants- These are a must and will help greatly to keep you warm.
